What is a LOLA Workshop?

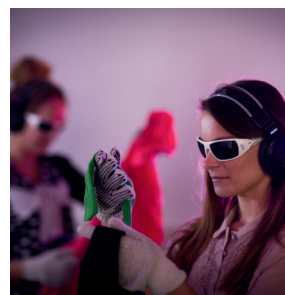
A 3-hour in-person program (2-hour Zoom) to walk families through the LOLA Individual Family playbook.
